Focused Symposia Format

- Each Focused Symposium will be 1.5 hours in duration
- A member of the Symposium team will Chair the Symposium
- It is anticipated that each Focused Symposium will include presentations from each panel member, discussion between panel members & discussion with the Symposium audience.

Abstracts are invited that:

- synthesize the findings of the latest research into shoulder & elbow dysfunction
- apply the findings of the latest research to current management of shoulder & elbow dysfunction
- address new & unique developments in the management of shoulder & elbow dysfunction
- describe innovative ways in which the management of shoulder & elbow dysfunction has been adapted to meet the changing needs of clinical practice

Selection Criteria

- Submitted abstracts will undergo a blind review process conducted by international reviewers.
- Preference will be given to international Symposia teams i.e. consisting of presenters from different countries/regions.
- The following principles will be used to review Abstracts:
 - The significance/importance of the topic addressed in the Symposium to an international audience of shoulder & elbow therapists
 - The contribution of the Symposium to the advancement of evidence-based management of shoulder & elbow dysfunction
